

IMPORTANT NOTICE

"SITE-BASED PUBLIC HOUSING WAITING LISTS"

Beginning Monday July 20, 2009 and for a temporary period of approximately two months thereafter, the Huntington WV Housing Authority will not be accepting walk-in housing assistance applications at its main office location (#300 W. Seventh Avenue in Huntington) from the general public for its public housing and primary Section 8 rental assistance programs. Only homeless eligible applicants interested in the Shelter-Plus Care Program or Veterans (VASH) Program will be accepted at the Authority's main office.

The Huntington WV Housing Authority offers site-based waiting list services for each of its ten (10) Public Housing locations in Huntington. Site-based wait lists applications are being accepted by the housing manager at the following locations at the designated times listed below for each site.

For Washington Square, Northcott Court, & Carter G. Woodson Apts.: Apply at #30 Northcott Court on Wednesdays from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

For Marcum Terrace: Apply at 2920 Marcum Terrace on Tues. & Thurs. from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.

For W. K. Elliott Apts. & Acquisition Homes: Apply at 510 Bridge Street on Mondays from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

Affordable public housing site based waiting list services are also available for near-elderly and elderly residency in the following locations.

Fairfield Tower: (1701 Franklin Ave.): Wednesdays from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

Riverview East: (225 Short St.): Tuesdays from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

Madison Manor & Trowbridge Manor: (Apply at 1329 Madison Ave. on Thursdays from 2:30 p.m. to 4 p.m.)

The new applicant must bring in verification of birth and social security cards for each household member and written proof of current total family income. Applicants may apply on-line by selecting from the drop-down box as to which site interests them at the following web address: www.huntingtonhousing.com. The Housing Authority awards applicant preferences based on individuals that are working, going to school/job training, or have a disability, are domestic violence victims, homeless, involuntary displaced, and have substandard housing issues.
