

WOODSHOP PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTED AT THE CAPITOL



On Tuesday, March 7th, students and staff of the Huntington School of Fine Woodwork, The Cabell County Youth Empowerment Program and the Youthbuild Program, all sponsored by the Huntington Housing Authority, participated in Workforce Investment Day at the Capitol. While there, students in the woodshop program presented Governor Joe Manchin III with a set of Adirondack chairs and a table in the shape of the State of West Virginia made by the students in the woodshop program. He told the audience the chairs would be placed on the front porch of the Governor's mansion.

The woodshop students displayed and sold lots of woodcraft items they made. Additionally, orders were taken for five more Adirondack chairs just like the ones presented to the Governor.
